New Business:

Cafeteria: Concern was expressed that the grade divisions should be separate with the cafeteria opening. Also, the potential for a lack of seating for all the students who want to eat there was brought

up. The principals feel that there should be enough spots for those who want to be in the cafeteria. As well, they commented that the grade 7/8 classes are supervised.

What is the visibility/school position with regards to vaping? Discussion was had regarding incidents of student vaping. Admin has been proactive by talking with various clubs/teams/students who need help. Discussion was had about having positive rewards for those who choose not to vape. It was brought up that the Health Unit has media awareness right now and Jenn L has signed up the school for more information for the students.
